- 2. Be aged between 17–24 years when you apply
- 3. Have lived in Wiltshire or Swindon for at least 2 years (or have your family home there if you're already at university)
- 4. Be eligible for funding through Student Finance England.
- 5. Be planning to study (or already studying) for your first undergraduate degree at a UK university, college, or institution
